Costs:

Studying in Bochum costs about 320 € per semester. That means that in addition to monthly costs for living (see table below), you have to pay the university 320 € twice a year (in September and March). Please take this into account when you are planning your studies in Germany!

Please note: The Federal Government of NRW is planning to introduce tuition fees up to a max amount of 1,500 € per semester for all non-EU students in all courses of study (Bachelor's, Master's, Diploma, state examination), starting from winter semester 2018/19. Doctoral students will most probably not be subject to these fees. Students enrolled at a university in NRW previous to winter semester 2018/19, will also most probably not be subject to the above-mentioned fees.
