- Participant with a child/children:** At least one child must be taken along during the entire stay abroad.

(Birth certificate and travel documents of the child/children)

- Employed student:** The employment must have been exercised continuously for at least 6 months within the last 12 months prior to departure. The employment is not to be continued during the stay abroad. Monthly earnings (net earnings of all activities per month added up) must be above €450 and below €850.
(Pay slips, tax returns)
- First-time academic:** Both parents or legal guardians do not have a degree from a university or university of applied sciences.
(Informal information on parents' educational qualifications, parents' honorary declaration)
